



## What will your support do for KHCC's children and families?



- \$100,000 Can provide the resources to cover the expenses of the After School or Teen Program for an entire year, such as tutoring, SAT prep and college trips, books, travel, food, supplies and community events.
- \$50,000 Can provide our SONYC (School's Out New York City) program with a professional staff member to teach a plethora of STEM activities for our middle schoolers including robotics, dance, poetry, and gardening.
- \$30,000 Can enable 30 of our Special Needs participants the chance to benefit from our quality programming all year round, allowing youth and young adults with autism and Down syndrome to be involved with our typically developing youth through our Reading Buddies, Best Buddies and Helping Hands programs.
- \$20,000 Can provide one year of specialized counseling for six child survivors of sexual abuse in our Changing Futures program.
- \$15,000 Can enable us to purchase a much needed new van to safely transport our Special Needs, Teen and After School participants from school to KHCC and home, on field trips and to deliver food to our second site for Early Childhood children.
- \$10,000 Can provide the Teen Center participants with a nightly, warm meal for a whole year. Over 75% of our participants are eligible for a free or reduced priced meals.
- \$7,500 Can beautify the KHCC facilities to ensure that our kids have a safe and happy environment to learn, grow and have fun!
- \$5,000 Can provide soil, seeds, and tools to maintain the garden for a year, which produces fruits and vegetables for our participants and their families. Talk about a renewable donation!
- \$2,000 Can provide 40 students with College Survival Kits. Each student attending our College Access workshop receives this Kit that includes necessities for college to which many of our students would not normally not have access.
- \$1,000 Can provide one year's worth of ESOL and Civics programing for one adult participant, and will give them the language skills to enhance their job prospects.
- \$500 Can provide over 100 books for the After School and Teen Center Library to be used in our Reading Buddies program where teens help our After School and Special Needs participants with their reading.
- \$200 Can provide 268 diapers that will be used in one week by the children in our Early Childhood Program.
